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#### RO means Run-On

A run-on sentence is when you have multiple sentences joined together into one big super mess of a word jumble. You gotta keep 'em separated.

Example: That house is cool, I like it.

#### I will edit it like this:

That house is cool, RO I like it.

# It is up to you to fix it. Ways to fix it:

- That house is cool. I like it. Period. Capitalize.
- That house is cool, and I like it. comma plus (and, but, or, so)
- 3. That house is cool; I like it. semi-colon (this only works for very closely related ideas)
- 4. That house is cool; moreover, I like it. semi-colon plus (however, moreover, furthermore, nevertheless) plus comma

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
