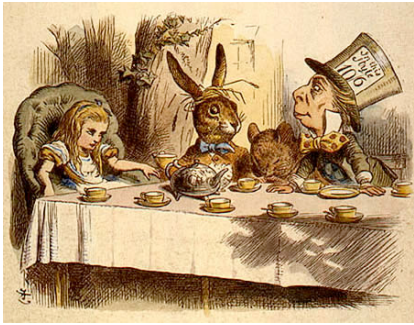


Tea Party: Quotes from the play



Instructions:

1. Get a slip of paper. Write down your quote:

What gender? What race? What does this person care about? Who do

(3-4 complete sentences)

If you need someone to repeat their line, please ask them! Say it with GUSTO! As you listen to the other students' lines, think about what their character's relationship is with your character. Think about what might be happening in the play when each character says their line.

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6. What do you think the play is about? What do you think are some major events that happen in the play? (3-4 complete sentences)

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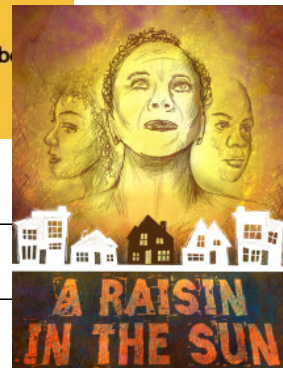
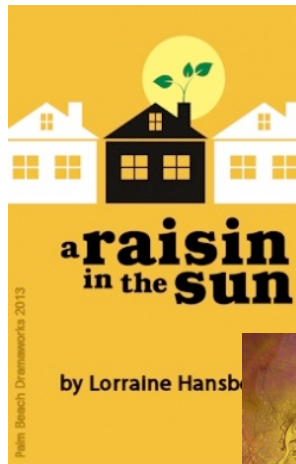
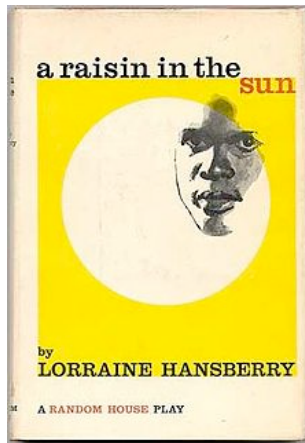
